

## Up-to-date as of winter 2022

New for 2021 – You will find in the list of books by Arthur Ransome that the American editions and the translations of his books are listed separately at the end of the sequence under his name. I hope that this will make it easier to find what you are looking for. Each of the titles by Ransome is now also followed by its date of publication.

More generally, for each title, where the date is shown in **BOLD**, it is the date of publication; where it is in ordinary type, it refers to the year of publication of the descriptive and illustrated printed *Catalogue* in which it appeared, followed by the page number. A very few copies of some of the Catalogues are available to buy from the Library at a cost of £5 including p&p. They are collector's items and well worth owning.
